





Students with scores of 3, 4, or 5 on Advanced Placement (AP) exams from The College Board may earn credit toward San Jose City College (SJCC) General Education (GE) for AS, AA, CSU GE-Breadth, and IGETC requirements in accordance to the chart below. Students who have earned credit from an AP exam should not take a comparable college course because transfer credit will not be granted for both.

GE credits and units granted at SJCC may differ from course credit and units granted by a transfer institution as AP policies, including course placement and course credit awarded, vary by college and/or university. Additionally, these institutions may require a score higher than a 3 on an AP exam to meet campus-specific general education or major requirements. To determine how AP scores will be used at the transfer institution, please consult with your advisor.
